Deal all the pack one card at a time to each player, until all the cards have been dealt. Do not look at the cards that are dealt you, but place them, face down, on the table in front of you.

Player at the left of dealer starts the game by playing a card face up in the center of the table from the top of his hand, without examining the card before playing. The next player at his left, plays from the top of his hand, the play continuing around the table, until someone plays a card which is of the **same number** as the card which was first laid down. Whoever thus duplicates the first card takes all the cards played, and puts them under his own cards. The player at his left then starts a new playing-pile, playing the top card from his hand, this pile being captured in the same manner, by the first player who duplicates the starting card. When a player runs out of cards, he is out of the game. When all but two players are out of the game, five piles more are played, when **the game ends** and the player having the **most cards WINS THE GAME.**
